



WEST TOWER B1F FLOOR PLAN




EAST TOWER 2F FLOOR PLAN



Lotte World Tower



Gyeongbokgung Palace


Deoksugung Palace

Deoksugung Palace is the smallest of Seoul's palaces. It is also the only palace that has two palaces in one and a Western-style garden. Joseon palace architecture and a Western-style palace complex, complete with two imposing neoclassical structures.



Popular Snacks

The most beloved snacks, Bunsik, literally meaning "food made from flour," is a term that refers to reasonably priced Korean dishes. The most adored bunsik include gimbap, tteokbokki and eomuk (fish cake). Bunsik can easily be found at traditional markets, street vendors, and around popular tourist attractions or shopping districts.



Traditional and Typical Korean Cuisine, Hansik

Hansik, refers to traditional Korean food, centered on rice, served alongside a bowl of soup and a variety of side dishes. Most dishes use meat and vegetables as the main ingredients and are boiled or steamed in brine or water rather than fried in oil. More than anything else, hansik's most outstanding feature is the amount of fermented foods. The most well-known are kimchi (fermented cabbage), ganjang (soy sauce), doenjang (soybean paste) and gochujang (Korean chili paste).


