



1ST EC MEETING

EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING ON 17TH NOVEMBER 2019 The Executive Meeting of the Association of Oral Maxillofacial Surgery was convened at Tulip Hall at Sheraton Grand Convention Centre Whitefield Bangaluru on 17 th November 2019 at 10 30 am Dr Pritham Shetty announced the commencement of the meeting and said we will be calling non members to attend the meeting to talk 1)Dr Deepak Kulkarni on National Registry 2)Dr Bhagwan Das Rai for Oral Cancer Awareness 2)Dr Arun Kumar for Repopularising Dentoalveolar Surgery 3)Dr Dipesh Rao for fellowships abroad The Minutes of the Meeting are as Follows The meeting was called to order by Dr Veerabahu M(President AOMSI)

In his Presidential Address Dr Veerabahu told this association is for the welfare of the members . Members expect professional guidance. Dr Veerabhau stressed the necessity of reaching out to the general public for creating awareness by

1)Creating awareness of the public by talking to organisations like Rotary etc

2)Making presentations in Indian Medical Association ,keeping a stall in IMA conferences

3)Collaborative programme with IDA

Date: 16th November 2019

Dr Veerabahu also felt it was necessary to lobby with the Dental Council of India and Ministry of

Health Senitise people like ambulance drivers, traffic policemen about the role of OMF Surgeon in Facial Injuries.

Venue: Bengaluru

Dr Veerabahu suggested the addition of subject of Management of Medically Compromised Patients and Medical Emergencies as a subject in BDS with BLS being a practical exam. He also suggested that ACLS course should be made mandatory before registration of MDS student. Dr Veerabahu suggested that OMF Surgeons should be trained in administering Nitrous Oxide to patients in Dental Clinics and that this can create new job opportunities for a maxillofacial surgeon. Also he suggested a Maxillofacial Surgeon should work with a radiation oncologist /medical oncologist

Dr Veerabahu suggested that the search engine in Google should be optimised so that OMFS will be

the first to appear when facial trauma is searched. Dr Veerabahu suggested that on Feb 13th the Association should insert a full page advertisement in all National Newspapers for creating awareness , though it might be an expensive affair it needs to

be done once. He suggested job opportunity in the website of AOMSI. Also Dr Veerabahu felt it was necessary to have a separate Maxillofacial Surgeon in each District. Hospital and that he will take up the responsibility of explaining this to Ministry of Health. Dr Veerabahu suggested that Dr Girish Rao take up the February 13th presentation which can be

presented in IDA,IMA etc to create awareness Briefing By Dr Deepak Kulkarni on Creating a National Registry

Dr Deepak Kulkarni at the outset mentioned that about 3 to 4 months back there was a serious case involving a maxillofacial surgeon wherein he had performed a surgery on a syndromic patient and the patient expired after 10 days. Though with his support the case was managed, he felt that there is no support system for maxillofacial surgeons. The whole idea of registry is to arrive at a consensus in our speciality so that it can safeguard members and a policy can be formulated to reach the Government. Dr Deepak K suggested a budget of 15 to 20 lacs of which the software cost will be borne by the

association ,the other cost to be borne by the association will be travelling and lodging of the committee members

He suggested that Trauma, pathology, orthognathic surgery, dentoal velolar surgery etc should be there in the registry

Dr Kulkarni suggested five members to be in charge and also that he will suggest their names. The job of the vendor will be to maintain the software and prepare the registry.

He also suggested a minimal cost to be paid by a member to maintain the registry. Association should subsidise this. The Vendor will be finalised by 20th January 2020

There will be meeting in PUNE ON 19TH Jan 2020 to be attended by the president, secretary, ex officio member to finalise the vendor.

He requested the sanction 25,000 to 30,000 Rs for Hall,AV system and food. Dr Kulkarni also said that he will make a presentation in the 3rd Ec meeting, in Mangalore 2020 and then in Indore 2021 where the members will enrol. He will be in charge of this initiative for 3 years.

Dr Deepak said he needs to travel to all major cities in India where he will sign up 300 Maxillofacial surgeons ie approximately 20 surgeons in each city

Dr Deepak suggested that even sensitive court cases can be uploaded wherein few people will be able to access by OTP

Dr Krishnamurthy said he had involved Dr Manjunath a maxillofacial surgeon from Oman who had provided the software of National Registry in Oman of which he was incharge .an amount of 2 lac was spent .However despite the members being provided no one responded and the upload is being done only at Mahaveer jain hospital in Bangalore

He mentioned that unless members provide the data it is difficult to fight case in a court of law. He also suggested that quotation from a few more vendors should be obtained before finalizing Dr Girish Rao was of the opinion that this cost of the registry should be borne by the association as members will not pay for that. Dr Kulkarni said he did not want to be in involved in the financial aspect .Dr Pritham told that a pilot study has to be done before the Mangalore conference. Dr Gosla Reddy said the property rights and specifications of the registry The Executive Committee approved the proposal by Dr Deepak to set up National Registry Dr Manikandan wanted to know wether its a prospective or retrospective or to be or retrospective or retrospective or retrosp

It was also mentioned that registry will include prospective data by Dr Pritham The Proposal for National Registry was approved by the EC

ORAL CANCER AWARENESS

Dr Bhagwan Das Rai discussed the Oral Cancer Awareness campaign carried out this year

Dr Rai mentioned that the collected data will be submitted to the Govt of India The survey was carried out in many states A total of 3618 transport drivers were eventing of the last states and the survey was carried out in many states

finding in the buccal mucosa. Hence he Dr Rai suggested that these flaws should be corrected the by calibrating the examiners

Dr Rai also suggeste a minimum of three volunteers from each state

Wats App Group of Members by the current week was empahasised by Pritham

Dr Pritham suggested to add Dr Lenka to the project



DENTOALVEOLAR PROMOTION CAMPAIGN

Dr Arun K in presented his ideas on Dentoalveolar promotion day/week/month

Dr Pritham said since already 13th Feb and 31st July were blocked the Dentoalveolar Awareness should be kept in July

Dr Veerabahu stressed that no objections would be entertained and this campaign will go on Dr Girish Rao wanted to know what is this for Dr Pritham replied that since we are promoting awareness of oral cancer, etc for dentoalveolar surgery pt don't go to oral surgeons but do to dentist hence the need for awareness.

Dr Pritham stressed that this will be observed not as a day but as a campaign only he told the members to avoid using the word day. He also said we need to take it forward only and create awareness that maxillofacial surgeon can do this. Dr Ashish Gupta Suggested that take up say dentoalveolar surgery this year next year maybe implants

Dr Arun Kumar said this has to be done in institutions and use AV aids to promote also he suggested standard post op instructions for which Dr Pritham said Dr Dabirs Consent form is available in the website

Dr Veerabahu told Dr Arun Kumar to come out with plan then he will see about funds

Dr Vijay Deshmukh said this campaign should be about professional awareness and promote on

Dr Girish Rao said there should be a link which can be downloaded by a patient

Dr Pritham suggested a video

Dr Veerabahu told all EC Members should follow Twitter

Dr Bhagwan requested the members to retweet the messages

Dr Pritham asked Dr Dipesh to connect with Dr Krishnamurthy and dr Vivek Reddy to take it forward

Dr Dipesh mentioned that he is in next gen for IAOMS and said this is the best time to do this .The

IAOMS asks to identify the prospective trainees below 40 years

Dr Emmanuel said that what if the fellow does not come back. Dr Veerabahu said that it is not relevant and the process of selection should be unbiased and transparent. Dr Pramod said several of the current EC members have had training abroad and have come back and there is an existing travel fellowship grant for 1,50,000/- which can be increased.

Dr Pritham said Dr Dipesh can do a webinar for the same. Dr Vijay Deshmukh asked why should the same trainee who has completed AOMSI fellowship be sent sent abroad .New trainees should be sent. 




