THE EXAMINATION PATTERN:

The examination shall be conducted in three parts:

1. Written examination:

There will be 100 MCQs covering all the aspects of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and the basic sciences. A rough marks distribution subject wise is: Basic sciences 10, Minor Oral Surgery 15, Trauma 20,

Orthognathic surgery 15, Oncosurgery and reconstruction 5, Benign lesions and cysts 10, Implants 5, Cleft and craniofacial 5, TMJ 5, Salivary gland and maxillary sinus 10.

2. Case presentation:

Each candidate has to present, with full documentation, two major cases that they have done (as the lead surgeon) during their career. The presentations should be sent to the IBOMS secretary at <u>examinations.iboms@gmail.com</u> in pdf format by 22nd November 2021.

3. Viva-voce:

The examiners will conduct a viva-voce on the various aspects of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery and related clinical sciences to assess the candidate's range and depth of knowledge and excellence in the specialty.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR APPEARING FOR IBOMS EXAMINATION

The major aim of the IBOMS, in awarding the Fellowship, is to recognize 'excellence' and hence the evaluation will be based also on the past performance of the candidate in the teaching of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and his/her contribution to the advancement of the specialty.

The candidates appearing for the examination should satisfy all the following requirements: -

- 1. Should be a member of the Association of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons of India in good standing.
- Threeyears' experience in clinical practice/teaching/research after MDS in Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery or equivalent qualification which is recognized by the Dental Council of India.
- 3. Each candidate therefore must obtain **30 points** to be eligible to appear for the examination as per the calculations given below.

Calculation of Points

The point system is introduced for ease of assessment by quantifying contributions and achievements.

- A. Publications- On OMFS related topics.
 - a) Articles:Only the first five authors of the article will be considered
 - i. Article published in National/International journals 10 points

- ii. Article published in State journals 5 points
- b) Editor / Author of book on OMFS 20 points / book(maximum)
- c) Contribution to books- 10 point /contribution (maximum)

B. CDE programs & Conferences in OMFS

- Chairman / Secretary / Scientific Committee Chairman of National Conference– 5 points/conference
- ii. Member, Organizing Committee- 2 points/conference
- iii. Chairman / Secretary / Co-Chairman, Regional Conference / Workshop-2 points/conference

iv. Faculty

- Faculty / Keynote speaker National /International Conferences: (AOMSI) - 10 points
- Faculty / Keynote speaker Regional Conference / Workshop 5 points

v. <u>Guest lectures in OMFS</u>

- International organizations- 10 points
- National level organizations- 5 points
- State level organizations- 3 points

vi. <u>Paper presentation in OMFS</u>

- International / National OMFS Conference (presenter) 3 points
- Co-author (International / National Conference) 2 point

vii. <u>Conference Attendance</u>

- International OMFS Conference 5 points / conference
- National (AOMSI Conference) 3 points / conference
- State level AOMSI conference 1 point / conference

C. <u>Teaching Experience in OMFS</u>

- ii. Post-graduate teaching 5 points / year

Should have more than 50% attendance - 5 points / year

F. <u>Thesis Guidance</u>

- G. Consultant in NABH hospital recognized by NABH: 2 points/year
- H. Covid duty (govt. certificate) minimum 1 week: 1 point per week. (VALID FOR THIS ONLY)
