

# **AOMSI FELLOWSHIP EXAM – 2026-2027**

### **Exam Guidelines**

# 1. Reporting Time

Candidates must arrive at the examination hall at least 45 minutes before the scheduled start time.

# 2. Laptop & Technical Requirements

Candidates must bring their personal laptop, fully charged, along with the charger/adapter.

Candidates must carry their own internet dongle and power bank for backup.

Ensure that network connectivity and laptop settings are checked and ready before the exam begins.

# 3. Login Credentials

User ID and Password will be provided at the examination centre on the day of the exam.

# 4. Permitted and Prohibited Items

Only mobile phones (for hotspot use only) and laptops are permitted inside the exam hall. Smart watches, Bluetooth devices, earphones, and other electronic gadgets are strictly prohibited.

Study materials, books, notes, or written material are not permitted in the exam hall.

### 5. Use of Mobile Phones

Mobile phone calls and usage (other than personal hotspot) are strictly prohibited during the examination.

# 6. Identity Verification

A valid photo identity card (College ID/Aadhaar/Driving Licence/Passport) must be kept visible on the desk throughout the examination.

#### 7. Exam Conduct Rules

Candidates are not permitted to leave the examination hall without final submission of their answers.

Candidates are strictly prohibited from:

- Discussing questions
- Using Google
- Accessing any website or online resources

# 8. Important Instructions Regarding MCQs (Very Important)

Once a candidate attempts a question, it cannot be left blank again.

Candidates can only change the selected option, but cannot undo or mark it as "Not Attempted."

Therefore, candidates are strongly advised to attempt questions very carefully.

# **Marking Scheme:**

Each correct answer: +4 marks

Each incorrect answer: -1 mark (negative marking)

Unattempted questions carry 0 marks.

### 9. Technical Issues

If any technical problem occurs during the exam, immediately inform the invigilator/exam centre coordinator.

### 10. Withdrawal from Examination

If a candidate wishes to withdraw from the exam, they must contact the Exam Centre Coordinator and submit a withdrawal form.

A withdrawal during the exam will be considered as one examination attempt.

# 11. Instructions by the Centre

All instructions regarding exam conduct will be explained by the Exam Centre Coordinator before the start of the exam.

Candidates must strictly follow all instructions given by the centre authorities.

### 12. Liability Clause

The Association shall not be responsible for any technical glitches if the candidate fails to comply with these instructions.
